Advocating for Change at the State Capitol

Advocating for disability services is exhilarating and liberating, as it empowers individuals, fosters inclusivity, and highlights the significant contributions of people with disabilities and the supporting community. It is a powerful way to promote change in policy and address the needs of the community as a whole. Each year, we are energized as we march into the Minnesota State Capitol for ARRM's Disability Services Day at the Capitol. Nearly 1,200 people across the state participated in the event this year!



Several legislators took the stage at the rally – including our own Rep. Brion Curran and Rep. Peter Fischer, who represent seven of our homes combined. We cheered loudly and chanted to make sure we were heard! That afternoon, we joined with other disability providers for meetings with our legislators. We met with 16 of our 17 legislators to share our stories and ask for their support
